THE PROJECT

Mitchell Kime Thompson Inc. acted as project manager on behalf of the Berens River First Nation for the design and construction of a \$13 Million sewer and water system. The project includes the build-out of a sewer and water process plant and installation and hook-up of 10 kilometres of pipe to over 120 homes in the community located 300 miles North of Winnipeg

THE TASK

The primary focus of the project was to install the infrastructure within a defined budget while maximizing use of local labour, machinery and developing First Nations expertise in procurement. MKT was responsible for administering project funds and representing the First Nation in discussions with the Department of Indian and Northern Affairs throughout the project.

THE RESULT

Local labour and equipment were heavily utilized, the project met and exceeded the allowed schedule and the Band was successful in the direct purchase, insuring and delivery of \$3.5 Million of materials.
